Pentecost, Church Is the Visible Sign of the Kingdom of God

The manifestation of the Holy Spirit in Pentecost is not only the birth of Christ's church, but God's first manifestation to all kinds of people. In Pentecost, God used the church to become the visible sign of God's kingdom. All Jesus' disciples obediently followed His mandate of meeting in a particular place where they received the presence of the Holy Spirit. That manifestation happened, regardless of their origin, language, culture or nation and turned their lives by imparting upon them spiritual gifts. Jesus made that particular room into a holy place.



Since then, God's people have been worshipping Him as one. For Christians, consecrated to God, our gathering rooms or churches are holy places where we seek, in our faith, God's presence. Temples and Sanctuaries are holy places where God's church is used to draw in our community, where we share our faith, hope and cultivate loving relationships in brotherhood.

We are seeking to update our Sanctuary and Bleekman Hall, so Tomoka UMC will continue its mission to affirm and to encourage our faith and harmonious relationships between each other. The Trustees of our church have identified at least three extremely important projects that will promote, not only the safety of all our members and visitors, but also promote a more homelike atmosphere that invites us to worship with our God.

The identified three projects that need our prompt attention are as follows: the replacement of the Sanctuary roof estimated between \$70,000 and \$75,000; the update of Bleekman Hall estimated between \$10,000 and \$15,000; and the exterior painting of both buildings estimated around \$10,000. Based on total estimates, we will need about \$90,000 to \$100,000 to complete these necessary projects that will protect and upgrade all of our facilities.

Listening to the request of TUMC Trustees team, our Finance Committee evaluated the financial situation and concluded that we need to act as soon as possible. They recommended the best way to complete these projects, is to request authorization from our church members to apply for a loan from the Florida United Methodist Foundation. It is for this reason that the entire membership of TUMC is being called to hold a Special Church Conference on Monday, June 17, at 6:00 p.m. in the Bleekman Hall.
